

**Advisory Task Force on COMPAL substantive issues:  
Terms of Reference**

- The Task Force will be composed of experts UNCTAD Competition and Consumer Protection (CCP) Branch.
- Staff will provide substantive inputs, commentaries, feedback, advice, participate in events in the field; and share knowledge and practical experience in this area, including best practices from COMPAL and other projects.
- The task force will be composed of a broad “Bench” and will work within small groups composed of people with specific expertise directly related to the activity at hand.

**Modus Operandi**

- Meetings will be organized well in advance to discuss TORs, sectoral studies, reports, programmes of seminars.
- Summaries of major issues to be discussed (through PPT, other) by the Task Force should be prepared when needed.
- Inputs provided by the Task Force will be incorporated as comments on specific activities and sent to NPCs. English versions of the outputs will be made available through reports, minutes, and posted on the COMPAL website.
- Time and resources permitting, members of the Advisory Task Force may participate in field activities.
- Minutes of all work undertaken by the Advisory Task Force will be kept as part of the COMPAL records.
